You will contribute to the programmatic and strategic work with a particular focus on managing the social media and other communication platforms of the network. You will engage with our members and partners in the region as well as globally and be a part of exciting and challenging work in pushing for women's and girls' reproductive rights and choices.

# **Qualifications and experience:**

- A degree in a related field (Medicine, social sciences, law, human rights, political science, women's studies, gender and development, mass communications.) strongly preferred but not necessary for candidates with relevant work experience.
- Relevant and advancing work experience preferred but fresh applicants with a high degree of motivation to learn and work will also be considered.
- Knowledge and appreciation of global and regional reproductive health and rights issues, including links to other

social movements.

• Excellent writing skills and experience managing social media platforms (such as Facebook, Twitter, Instagram and blogs at a minimum) with original content generation necessary.

- Self- regulating and highly motivated, with an ability to maintain deadlines and be organized.
- Deep commitment to the goal and vision of the network
- Ability and flexibility to travel within the region.
- Ability to work collaboratively with a high performing team.

- The salary is negotiable based on qualifications and experience. This is a full-time position, however under some circumstances parttime can be negotiated
